CATCHING

Our team of professional dog catchers visits the designated areas to identify and separate sterilized dogs from those that are yet to be sterilized. Some dogs are friendly and can be gently carried by hand, while others are more fearful and need to be caught using a humane dog-catching net.

Each dog is handled with the utmost care to minimize stress and ensure their safety. After capture, the dogs are transported to our shelter in an animal ambulance.



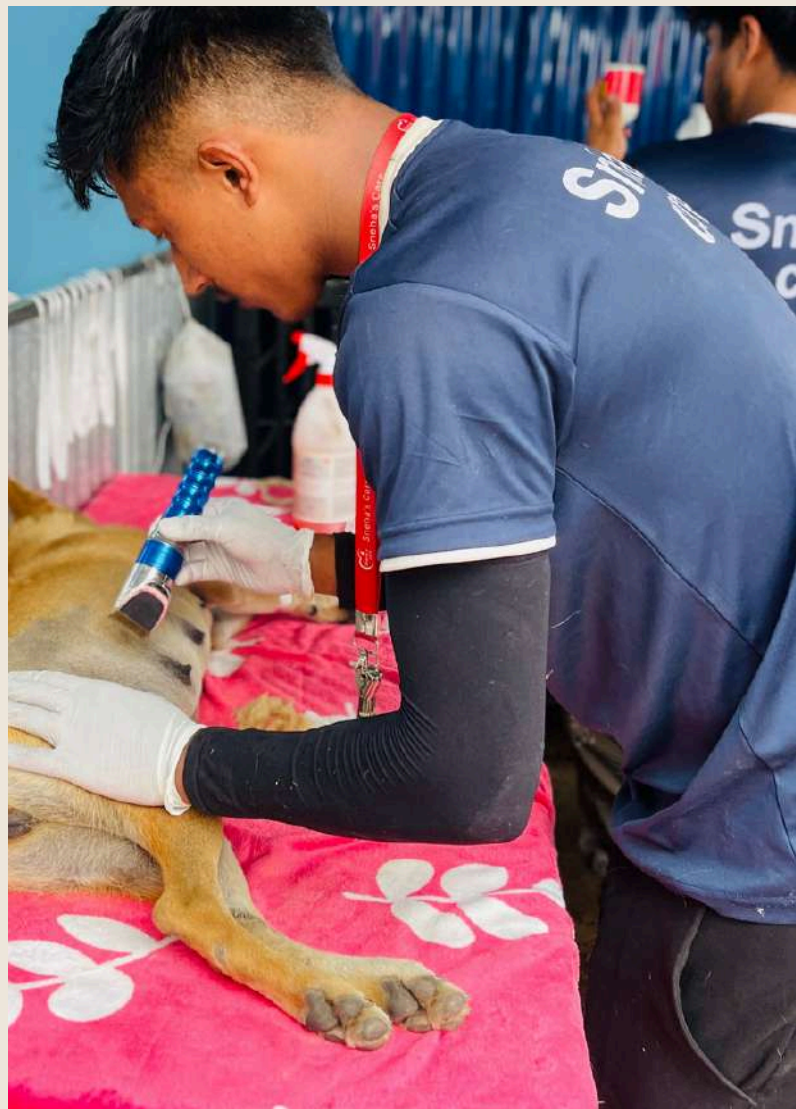


RECORDING

Accurate record-keeping is a crucial part of any birth control campaign to ensure that each dog is properly documented, marked, and returned to their original area after surgery and recovery. Without proper records, there is a risk of dogs being misplaced, which can create confusion and disrupt their familiar environment. Careful tracking helps maintain the integrity of the program and ensures the well-being of every dog involved.

PREPPING

After careful recording and monitoring, our team of veterinary technicians begins preparing the dogs for surgery, one by one. Preparation includes confirming their gender, shaving the surgical area, placing an intravenous (IV) cannula, and administering anesthesia. Each step is carried out with precision to ensure the safety and comfort of the dogs throughout the procedure.



SURGERY

Our team of two professional veterinary doctors then begins the surgery process, operating on the dogs one by one. Throughout the procedure, veterinary technicians remain on site to assist wherever needed. Our doctors perform each surgery with great precision, ensuring that the sutures are placed carefully and securely to promote faster healing and minimize the risk of complications.



RECOVERY

After surgery, each dog is placed in a crate and given time to safely wake up from the anesthesia. Our team members remain on site at all times to closely monitor the dogs, ensuring they are safe, checking for any signs of complications, and inspecting their surgical wounds. Once awake, the dogs are provided with a nutritious, warm meal to support their healing process and help them regain their strength.





RELEASE

Once the surgical wounds have healed, the dogs are carefully transported in the animal ambulance. Our team of catchers then cross-checks each dog against the records to ensure accuracy before releasing them back into their original communities. This careful process helps maintain the bond between the dogs and their familiar environment, supporting their long-term well-being.

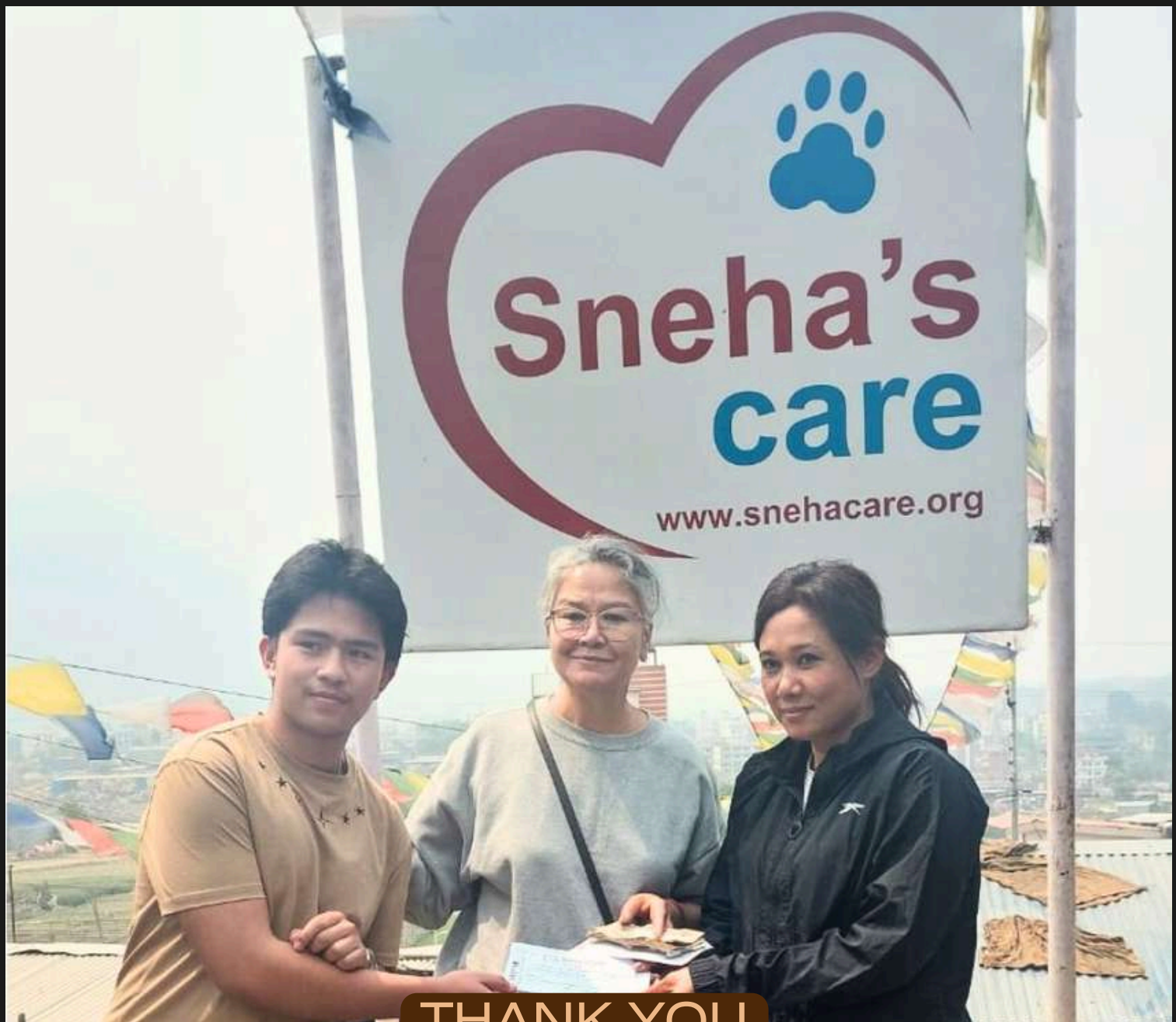

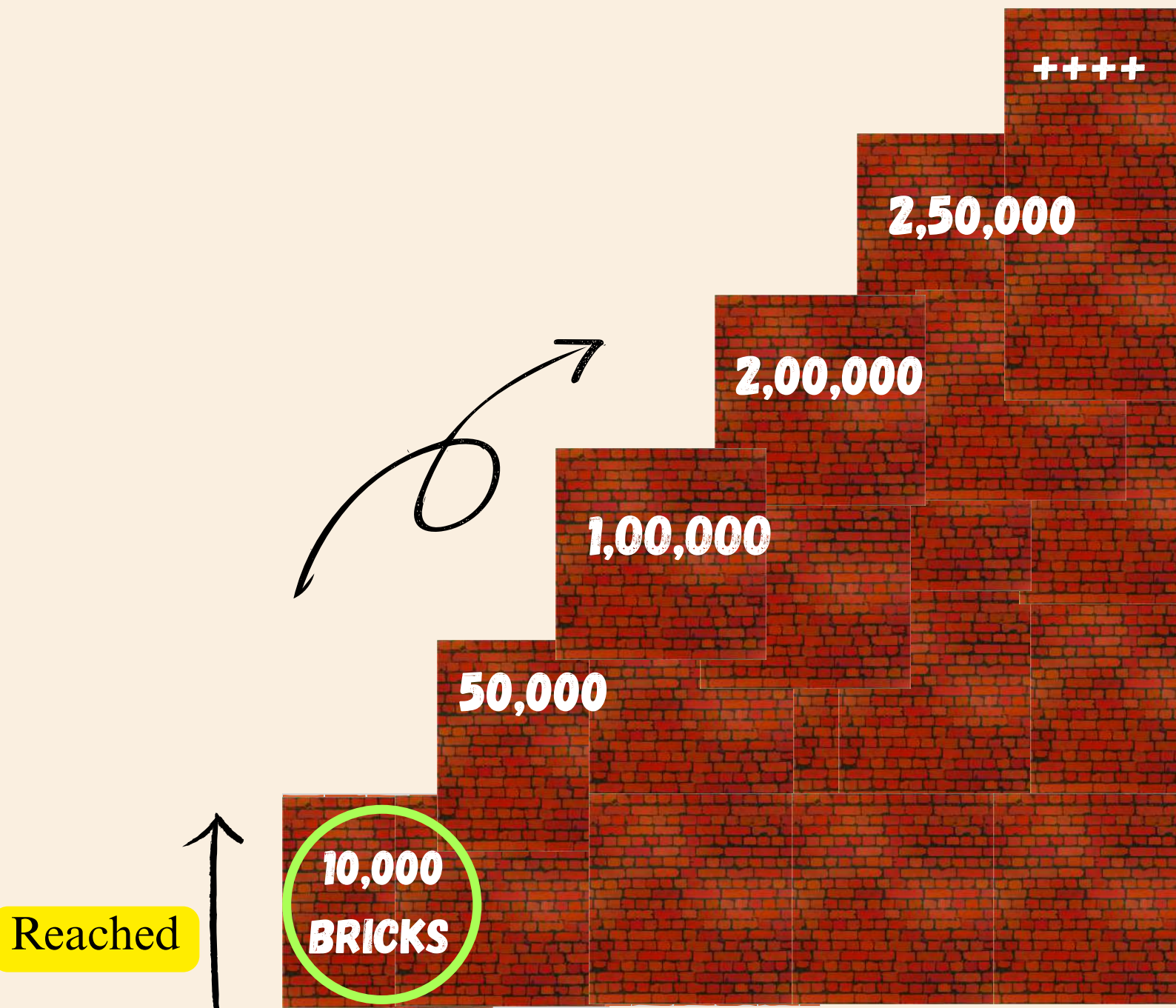

At Sneha's Care, we rescue not only dogs but also farm animals such as cows, buffaloes, pigs, goats, and sheep. Caring for farm animals requires specialized skills, especially when they are sick. It also demands the use of special equipment such as lifting slings, and proper transport supplies to ensure their safety and comfort.
