Tiny was brought to us by a kind informer from Bhaktapur. She was a victim of a hit-and-run case. A speeding vehicle hit her and fled the scene, leaving her with traumatic wounds and spinal nerve damage. Her healing journey needs medicine, therapy, and care, which all come at a cost. Our veterinary team is doing everything possible monitoring her closely and giving her continuous medical care.

MOBILE TREATMENT CASES

HIT AND RUN

This month, we received several heartbreaking cases of dogs severely injured in vehicle accidents. In one case, a dog was hit so badly that an entire limb was missing. Another had large portions of skin torn away. Since they could not be brought to the shelter, our team rushed to the location and provided mobile treatment on-site; cleaning wounds, dressing injuries, and giving pain relief.





SKIN ISSUES

This month, we also treated many heartbreaking cases of dogs suffering from severe skin infections. Some had lost almost all their fur, with raw patches of skin covered in painful wounds and constant itching. Others were so weak from secondary infections that they could barely stand. Many of these dogs had been living like this on the streets for weeks, often ignored because of their appearance. Our mobile team reached them in their own communities, providing medicines and pain relief.

WOUND

This month, we received numerous cases of wounded dogs. With the frequent rains, many of the wounds had become soggy, foul-smelling, and infested with maggots, causing immense suffering. Our team visited the locations multiple times a week to clean the injuries, provide timely dressing, and continue treatment until the dogs began to heal.





Our team acted swiftly and performed a delicate surgery to remove the tumor. She is now under our close observation, receiving both medical support and the warmth of a safe environment.


