ANOTHER LIFE SAVED IN TIME



During our ongoing ABC campaign, we received information about a female community dog named Mit who was suffering from a deep and painful wound on her stomach in the Pasupatinath–Mitrapark area. The injury appeared severe and was most likely caused by contact with a sharp object, leaving her vulnerable to infection and extreme discomfort.



Our rescue team responded immediately and brought Mit to safety. Upon examination, her wound required urgent medical attention. She was provided with proper wound cleaning, medication, and necessary treatment to prevent further complications. Despite the pain she endured, Mit showed remarkable resilience throughout the rescue and treatment process.

Mit is currently under our constant observation and care at the shelter. Our team is closely monitoring her healing, ensuring she receives timely medication, proper nutrition, and a clean, comfortable space to recover. Her condition is stable, and we remain hopeful for her full recovery.

TWO PET DOGS WERE BROUGHT TO OUR SHELTER AFTER THEY APPEARED TO HAVE LOST THEIR WAY, WANDERING FROM PLACE TO PLACE IN FEAR. VULNERABLE AND CONFUSED, THEY WERE BEING ATTACKED BY OTHER DOGS AND WERE CLEARLY DISTRESSED. WE KEPT THEM SAFE AT THE SHELTER WHILE WE SEARCHED AND WAITED, HOPING THEIR FAMILY WOULD BE FOUND.

THANKFULLY, THE WAIT WAS NOT LONG. THEIR OWNER CAME FORWARD, AND THE MOMENT OF REUNION WAS FILLED WITH RELIEF AND JOY. THE TWO DOGS ARE NOW BACK WHERE THEY BELONG—SAFE, LOVED, AND REUNITED WITH THEIR FAMILY.
